Hooray, School is Open!

As most of you know by now, after over 20 months of being closed due to a "covid holiday," schools in Uganda have reopened, beginning their new school year this January, 2022. Children will again be able to continue their learning, receive a nutritious school lunch each day, learn about Jesus in weekly classes and prayer before each meal. With a maximum of 50 students in a class, Mweruka Junior School has 400 plus students registered.



Collapsed Latrine Replaced! Financial help needed

The 15 year old pit latrine collapsed. Based on an enrollment of 400 students, Mweruka Junior School fell out of government compliance for primary schools. Just prior to school reopening completion of a 6-stall latrine returned MJS to compliance. The total cost was \$4,442. Our funding campaign is \$2,900 short of meeting the cost.
